The high burden of infectious diseases and the cost of inaction

Infectious diseases like TB, dengue, malaria, chikungunya, pose a grave threat, especially to the developing world, with India facing an outsized proportion of the burden. Emerging threats like climate change and antimicrobial resistance are challenging years of progress, making these diseases harder to control. The cost of inaction is clear.

The power of innovations and the gaping funding gap

Disruptive science- and technology-based innovations offer hope to bridge this need, especially at the primary care level where the gap is the deepest and widest. Yet, funding for development and deployment of innovations for infectious diseases has stayed insufficient, fragmented with the largest share coming from the government.

The India Health Fund story

India Health Fund (IHF), conceived by the Tata Trusts in strategic partnership with The Global Fund in 2017, has been bridging this critical funding gap by bringing patient capital to derisk the development of science and technology-based solutions for infectious diseases. Today, with a 14-innovation strong portfolio, five of which have already entered the public health system, IHF has established itself as the only dedicated source of funding for innovation in infectious diseases in India and is one of the few funding organizations in the world with a singular focus on infectious diseases.
